

Easy 6x6 Mini-Album Folio – inspired by Paper Pixi Ink ([Link](#))

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Create a charming and functional mini-album folio using simple cuts and scores, perfect for showcasing 6x6 patterned papers. This project features a three-panel base with interactive flaps and a pocket for extra storage.

Perfect for beginners and seasoned crafters alike, this folio is a quick and satisfying build with endless creative possibilities!

Cut Paper:

- (a) 1 – $6\frac{1}{4} \times 7\frac{1}{4}$ (Album base left)
- (b) 1 – $6\frac{1}{4} \times 6\frac{1}{4}$ (Album base center)
- (c) 1 – $6\frac{1}{4} \times 4\frac{3}{4}$ (Album base right-side)
- (d) 4 – $6\frac{1}{4} \times 4\frac{3}{4}$ (Flaps)
- (e) 1 – $7\frac{1}{4} \times 3$ (Pocket)

Scoring Instructions:

- (a) On $7\frac{1}{4}$ side – Score at $6\frac{3}{4}$ and each $\frac{1}{8}$ " till $6\frac{1}{4}$
- (c) On $4\frac{3}{4}$ side – Score at $4\frac{1}{4}$ and each $\frac{1}{8}$ " till $3\frac{3}{4}$
- (d) On $4\frac{3}{4}$ side of each – Score at $4\frac{1}{4}$
- (e) On $7\frac{1}{4}$ side - Score $\frac{1}{2}$ and $6\frac{3}{4}$ (or $\frac{1}{2}$ on each side)
 - a. On 3" side – Score at $2\frac{1}{2}$ (or $\frac{1}{2}$)

Assembly Instructions:

1. Burnish all score lines (including $\frac{1}{8}$ extra scores this the spine of the album.
2. Paper (a) [$6\frac{1}{4} \times 7\frac{3}{4}$] on the $\frac{1}{4}$ score add glue and attach the (b) $6\frac{1}{4} \times 6\frac{1}{4}$ piece of paper.
3. Paper (b) [$6\frac{1}{4} \times 6\frac{1}{4}$] opposite side of paper glue (c) the $\frac{1}{4}$ flap to paper (b).
4. On the $6\frac{1}{4}$ flap (a) glue (d) [$6\frac{1}{4} \times 4\frac{3}{4}$] to each side of the flap.
 - a. Mitter the $\frac{1}{2}$ flap on both sides.
 - b. Make-sure to glue inside of the score line so album will still close.
5. On the middle (b) [$6\frac{1}{4} \times 6\frac{1}{4}$] glue (d) [$6\frac{1}{4} \times 4\frac{3}{4}$] to each side of the album.
 - a. Mitter the $\frac{1}{2}$ flap on both sides.
 - b. Make-sure to glue inside of the score line so album will still close.
6. Paper (e) pocket miter the right and left $\frac{1}{2}$ bottom scorelines where the bottom score and the side scores meet.
7. Attach (e) to the bottom of the Album base center (step 5).

Decoration Tips: Use 6x6 papers for the main panels and 4zzzxx6 pieces for flaps, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " border for a polished look.
