Create a charming and functional mini-purse for your Lip gloss using simple cuts and scores, perfect for showcasing your scraps.

Perfect for beginners and seasoned crafters alike, this project is a quick and satisfying build with endless creative possibilities!

Cut Paper:

- (a) 1 – 3x4 (Purse Base)
- (b) 1 – 2 x ½ (Chapstick holder)
- (c) 2 - 3 x ¼ (Purse Handles)
- (d) 4 – 3 x ½ (Top of purse decoration, outside and inside)

Scoring Instructions:

- (a) On 4 side – Score at ½, 1 ¾, 2 ¼, and 3 ½
- (b) On 2 side – Score at 1/8 on both sides

Assembly Instructions:

1. Burnish all score lines
2. Paper (b) [1 – 2 x ½] using a pencil curl the paper on the 1/8 score add glue and attach the (a) 3 x 4 piece of paper on the outside of the inside scorelines.
3. Paper (c) [3 x ¼] using a pencil curl the paper glue to the top of (a) the ½ flap to paper.
4. Glue the (d) top of purse decoration to the outside and inside of the purse
 - a. Optional use a die, scissors or decorative edge.
5. Optional add a hook and loop closure to the top middle of the purse to hold together.
